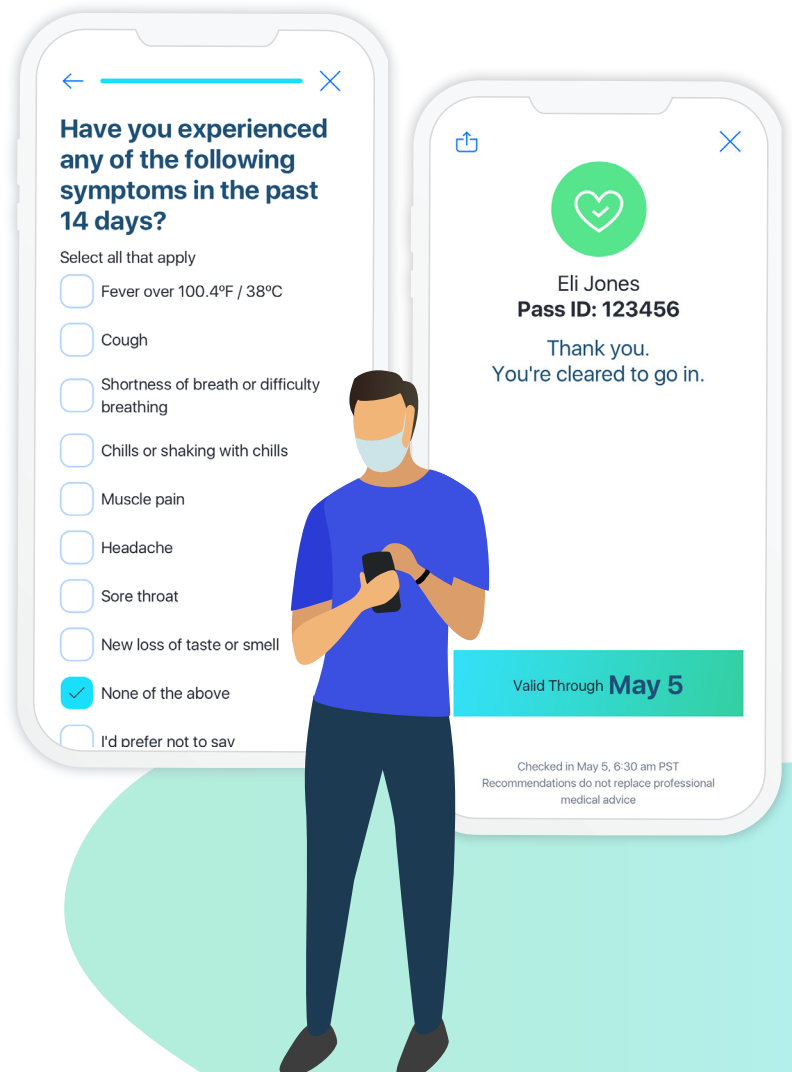

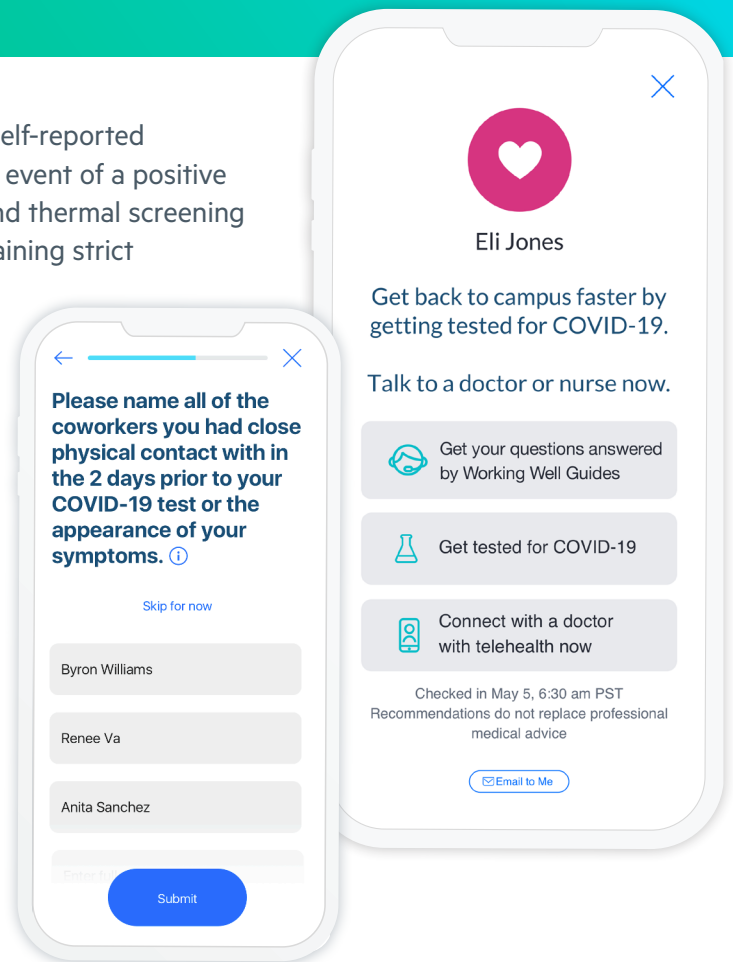
Behavioral health
