Steel Dynamics saves an estimated \$870k on medical spend using Castlight





Steel Dynamics is one of the largest domestic steel producers and metals recyclers in the United States based on estimated annual steelmaking and metals recycling capability, with facilities located throughout the United States, and in Mexico. Steel Dynamics produces steel products, including hot roll, cold roll, and coated sheet steel, structural steel beams and shapes, rail, engineered special-bar-quality steel, cold finished steel, merchant bar products, specialty steel sections and steel joists and deck. In addition, the company produces liquid pig iron and processes and sells ferrous and nonferrous scrap.

How Steel Dynamics Measures Impact

Steel Dynamics initially chose Castlight in 2015 to help employees become more informed healthcare consumers and increase engagement in health benefits. What started with providing a tool for employees to gain insight into their healthcare spending, transformed into a way for employees to stay engaged in their health journey. Now in 2018, Castlight demonstrates Value on Investment (VOI) to Steel Dynamics using three key pillars: direct cost savings, program engagement, and employee satisfaction.

The company's return rate—the percentage of people who come back to Castlight for searches or information within any given 90-day period—is also high at 53%.
Employee Satisfaction	50 NPS	Net Promoter Scores are used across industries to gauge the loyalty of the user to the product. Healthcare organizations average a 18 NPS, insurance companies average 38 NPS. Responding Steel Dynamics employees give Castlight a NPS of 50 - well above the typical healthcare or insurance industry averages.
